



KEY ISSUES AND CHALLENGES

- Fire safety building regulations: Standard 2.7 Spread of fire on external walls.
- Net-zero targets (EPC Band C)
- Associated risks from retrofit, such as condensation → need for sufficient ventilation
- Achieving compliance without adversely impacting on the historic fabric and significance of a building
- Blanket approach to Buildings Regs
